Dunedin Golf Club Open for Golf and Food-To-Go

According to the Florida "Stay at Home" mandate, golf and restaurants are essential businesses, golf for recreation and restaurants because we all have to eat.!

If you are golfing, new rules include only one rider to a cart, staying six feet apart at all times, and practicing all hygiene recommendations. Carts are being sanitized before they are released to a golfer and all commonly touched items have been removed from carts. Cups have been inverted so golfers do not have to touch flag sticks. Bike Safety

Many of our residents are riding bikes and walking these days for exercise and simply to get out of the house. We are lucky to have access to one of the most popular bike trails in Florida, but Pinellas County is the deadliest regional county for bike injuries and deaths. Most of these incidents are caused when a car makes a left turn into a bike at an intersection. For safety, Florida law requires the following.

- Bikes must follow car traffic rules including riding on the same side of the road as cars and obeying traffic lights and signs.
- Children under 16 are required to wear helmets. Adults are advised to wear helmets.
- A headlight visible for 500 ft. and a rear reflector are required between sunset and sunrise.
- Car drivers must give bicyclists a minimum of 3 feet of clearance when passing and must yield to a bicyclist in a bike lane or intersection.



More safety tips that can prevent injuries and reduce frustrations

- Don't ride with headphones or text on your phone so you are alert to things happening around you.
- Car drivers should look around before opening their door to avoid striking a passing bicyclist with their door.
- Use a bell or your voice to warn walkers or bikers you are passing. No warning has been a problem lately on our trail.
- On the Pinellas Trail, stay on the right and pass on the left of the biking lane.
- If you stop on the trail, don't block it for other riders or walkers.
- Be courteous and respect the other trail users including those who are slower than you.

Walkers, remember to walk facing traffic when you can't walk on a sidewalk. This protects everyone. Cars, bicyclists and pedestrians can share the road and the trail, but only when they respect each other and follow traffic and trail rules.

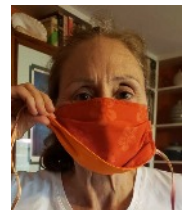
